Dear Farmers' Market Participant,

It may not feel like it, but spring is fast approaching and it is time to once again think about the upcoming Farmers' Market. The Mauston Farmers' Market will be held again on Saturday mornings, starting at 7am until sold or 2pm, May 7th through October 29th, 2016. Tuesday Nights, starting at 2pm-6pm, May 3rd through October 25th, 2016. Also enclosed are two registration forms (one for the chamber office and one for the State of Wisconsin). Both of these need to be filled out and pay \$25 Non-Refundable Registration Fee before you will be sent your Registration Certificate.

NEW THIS YEAR:

1. **NEW LOCATION** is at the Juneau Co Courthouse Lawn.
2. There is a \$20 Non-Refundable Registration Fee. Make payable to the Mauston Chamber.
3. This Year there will be 3 (three) representatives that will be appointed or can volunteer to help manage and run the Farmers' Market.

Please fill out your Registration Form, State of Wisconsin Temporary Event and a check or money order of \$20 (Non-Refundable Registration Fee) to the Chamber office. On the form for the State of Wisconsin, it asks for your Wisconsin Seller's Permit Number (full number), Social Security Number (only need the last four digits of SSN), or Federal ID Number (full number). You need to supply only one of these numbers. If you have an e-mail address, we would appreciate this as well. It might prove as a good way for us to stay in touch and share ideas.

Upon receipt, you will receive a Registration Certificate that must be displayed in your area each Saturday/Tuesday, and must be visible from the street. You cannot participate until you receive your registration certificate.

Also this year we are asking all sellers of food products to become Wisconsin WIC Certified. If you are interested in becoming a vendor for the Senior Farmer Market Nutrition Program, please contact Lori Hadac at 608-847-9373 or April Martell at 608-847-9333.

Wisconsin WIC & Senior Farmers' Market and Division of Food Safety on Fruit and Vegetable Farms, prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, Division of Food Safety, will become a huge part of the Mauston Farmers' Market for 2016.
