Local food pantries receive donations from The Bank of Mauston

Mauston, January 2 – We all know the holidays can be a trying time on families in need. To help ensure that these individuals had enough food for their holiday meals, The Bank of Mauston recently hosted its 30th annual Food Pantry Drive.



But the bank didn’t stop there either. This was a tradition started by the late Tom Schmidt many years ago, and once again the Key Club’s efforts helped put The Bank of Mauston at its maximum donation of \$5,000 - making 2013 one of the larger donation years.






