## 2020 Schedule of Services

### Leaves -

The City provides curbside pickup of leaves on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of the month. No phone call is required

### Spring -

Place leaves in brown paper bags (no plastic bags) and place in the boulevard for pickup.

### Fall -

(September 10-November 30) rake leaves to the curb and the city will vacuum them, or put in brown paper bags and place them curbside for pickup. Please be sure to keep leaves away from poles and hydrants so the vacuum can reach them.

### Brush -

The City provides curbside pickup of brush the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Monday's from April 4 - October 23. No phone call is required for pickup

Brush must be placed in the boulevard parallel to the street, but not in the street

### Christmas Tree Collection -

Christmas trees are collected curbside from January 1 - February 1. Light strings, ornaments, tree stands and other metal or plastic must be removed.

### Residential

#### Spring & Fall Clean-up

**Spring Clean-Up** - April 20-22 on your regular garbage pick-up day.

**Fall Clean-up** - October 12-14 on your regular garbage pick-up day.

Ads placed in the local paper and on the City website prior to clean-up week will provide more information on what types of items will be picked up.

### Street Lights

If you observe a problem with a streetlight in the city, please contact the Public Works Clerk who will notify the correct repair agency.

### Fire Hydrants

Fire hydrants that are blocked or difficult to access due to snow and ice impede emergency fire response. Help reduce the risk by keeping fire hydrants accessible and clear of snow and ice at least 3 feet around hydrant.
